* Retains a budget and disburses funds to cover expenses by collecting annual dues. AsHFA has been granted tax-exempt status by the IRS.

* Publishes a newsletter and directory using funds provided by members.

* Establishes committees to facilitate its work.

* Develops and sponsors programs for the annual AsMA Scientific meeting.

* Has established liaison with APA Division 21, the Human Factors & Ergonomics Society, DOD HFE Technical Advisory Group, SAE G10, SAFE, and other scientific organizations to exchange information and further its goals.

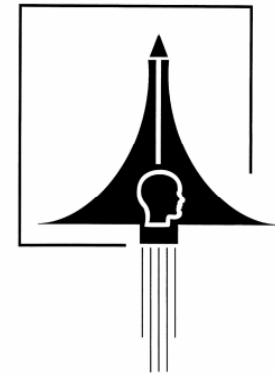
