Election Process Reform Initiative of 2007

Motion to approve the process by which new Fellows are elected:

A new process by which Fellows are elected shall be instituted for the election of the 2008 Class of Fellows and for the class years that follow. This process is in accordance with bylaws Article IV, Fellowship, Section B.4, "Fellows will be elected annually through a published process developed by the Fellows and approved by Council." The features of this process include the building of a slate of nominees by a Fellows Nominating Committee, the management of evaluation criteria by a Fellows Evaluation Committee, election by vote on the slate of nominees at the annual Meeting of Fellows, and voting by proxy for those who can not attend. The process is based on the Fellows Election Process Assumptions document of March 18, 2007 and the Fellows Group Organizational Structure and Fellows Election Process Milestones document of March 23, 2007. These documents should be maintained for reference and the Aerospace Medical Association Policy Procedures document should be changed to reflect the new election process.
