
## AEROSPACE MEDICAL ASSOCIATION HONORS NIGHT AWARDS--NEW ORLEANS 2007



## President's Citations

Dr. Jennings presented the 2007 President's Citations to (lower left photo) Drs. Dan Callan (right) and (lower right photo) to Stanley R. Mohler (left).

Daniel Callan, D.O., was presented the President's Citation for his sustained performance supporting the Annual Scientific Meeting. He has worked for years as a Chair of the Registration Committee, with the arrangements, taking tickets for various functions, etc., and for all the hard work that he has quietly done to help us enjoy the meeting each year. As Thomas Edison said, "I have friends in overalls whose friendship I would not swap in favor of the kings of the world." Dan is one of those folks who have lead the way with his work.

Stanley R. Mohler, M.D., was presented the President's Citation because of his continued positive approach to the field of aerospace medicine. This is unusual in medicine and particularly as one ages. A quote from Steinbeck explains how many of us are: "It is the nature of a man as he grows older...to protest against change, particularly change for the better."
